Clan Baird Society Worldwide Foundation, Inc., a 501 (C) 3 charity has been established

For a very long time, members have asked us to set up a Foundation/Trust/Charity, so that any donations they give could be tax deductible and we could pool our resources as members, to do good work for the Bairds. Due to the work of several Society Board members, namely our Commander Richard Baird, Heather Baird Snyder, Stanford Baird, Branton Baird, and myself, all the required paperwork and Charters were written, rewritten, prepared, and checked by attorneys, then ultimately submitted. It only took most of 2020, but gave us something to do while we were in lock-down for Covid-19. The Society can feel very good that something so important and valuable was accomplished during such a difficult and stressful time in our history.

We are most happy to announce that we have established Clan Baird Society Worldwide Foundation, Inc. and it is classified as a 501(c) 3 charity. We are ready to accept donations for the

2020 tax year. We received our IRS deductible status a few weeks ago. It is October, and donations have to be in by December 31st for us to give you a letter for the 2020 tax year.

The original charter members of the Foundation Board are Debra Baird, President and Co-Chair, Stanford Baird, 1st Vice President and Co-Chair, Branton Baird, 2nd Vice President and Treasurer, Alton Wilson, Secretary, John Baird, Ross Baird, Anna Ryan Ferguson, and our Commander, Richard Baird, Members-at-Large.

Richard and Ross are working to set up a Foundation as a charity in the United Kingdom. We will let you know as soon as that is ready.

There are many Baird graves at the Kirk, and there is an urgent need to protect the tombs, as well as the inscriptions. SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

Bob and Karen Beard, our Society Treasurers, have generously donated a cask of 14-year-old Scotch to CBSW. It is now bottled with a beautiful label designed by our Publicist and Gryphon Editor, Heather Baird Snyder, and is available for sale in Scotland. Our Commander Richard has very kindly offered storage to us at no cost, at his Rickarton Estate.

The Commander's Dram is a 14 year old single malt Scotch whisky distilled and bottled in Scotland. It was distilled at Tullibardine Distillery, in a refilled Sherry Butt Cask #33 in March 2006. It was bottled by Whiskybrokers in September 2020 at a strength of 56.8%.

Commander's Dram is £65 per bottle. You can reserve your own bottle (or bottles) by contacting Richard or Ross Baird. Purchase your whisky through PayPal on the Clan Baird.org or ClanBairdSociety.com. You can pick it up the next time you visit Scotland. Import taxes are so high, we have not figured out how to manage that yet. So at the moment, we are picking up our own bottles while in the homeland. It is a great excuse for taking a trip to Scotland!









veterans on challenging expeditions around the world, to re-invoke the sense of adventure and teamwork. We provide 'adventure therapy' and a simple concept has proven itself by the testimonies from the veterans we have helped. During and after an

expedition guys have a more positive mind set and future outlook.

We train each team before leaving for an expedition gaining a LANTRA off road driving qualification and a first aid at work certificate. This gives everyone the confidence to start the expedition with the knowledge required and is also transferable to help with employment."

A recent expedition began in Stonehaven on the North Sea, with Richard hosting, and traveled all the way across Scotland to the Atlantic Ocean. As part of the opening of this trip, the
